THE IDEAL STUDENT

The Visual Arts Department seeks students who have a passion to create art, are self-motivated, take direction well, and are willing to push themselves.

PROGRAM OFFERINGS

Residential High School Program

A two-year program for high school juniors and seniors who apply in 10th grade. Tuition is free. Students learn each visual art discipline and create a body of work as a final semester project.

Academy Program

A two-week summer program for rising 10th grade students who apply in 9th grade. Students are deeply invested in four classes over two weeks.

Arts Odyssey Program

A one-week summer program for rising 8th and 9th grade students who apply in 7th or 8th grade. Students are introduced to four disciplines in one week.

AUDITION PROCESS

Applicants for the **Residential High School** and **Academy** programs submit several pieces of artwork based on specific guidelines. These applicants will attend a drawing workshop and bring an additional portfolio of work to an interview with program instructors.

In the Governor's School's **Visual Arts Program**, students gain exposure to a broad spectrum of mediums while developing the conceptual and creative skills they need to explore and refine their own imagery and self-expression.

Students learn fundamental processes and techniques from faculty who are established artists in their field. Depending on the program, students gain hands-on experience with studio practices in the following disciplines:

- Animation and CGI
- Architecture
- Ceramics
- Drawing
- Graphic Design
- Metal Work
- Painting
- Photography
- Printmaking
- Sculpture

In the Residential High School Program, students also build experience preparing portfolios, exhibiting artwork, and entering competitions.

2020-2021 STUDENT PROGRAMS



The South Carolina Governor's School for the Arts and Humanities cultivates young artists from across the state through pre-professional training in the areas of Creative Writing, Dance, Drama, Music, and Visual Arts. Students learn from world-renowned faculty who are established, practicing artists. Nestled behind Falls Park in scenic downtown Greenville, students live in a safe and supportive environment where they have everything they need to pursue their artistic passion and discover who they are as individuals and as artists. Any South Carolina resident in grades 6-10 can apply to the Governor's School's various programs.

RESIDENTIAL HIGH SCHOOL

As a public, residential high school, students explore and refine their talents in a one-of-a-kind, master/apprentice community while receiving a nationally recognized academic education that fulfills the requirements for a South Carolina high school diploma.

Juniors and seniors, as well as exceptional sophomores in Music and Dance, live on campus for the typical school year.

Students apply in the 10th grade for Creative Writing, Drama, Music, and Visual Arts and in the 9th or 10th grade for Dance. All students choose one art area and explore various mediums or disciplines within that area with established arts faculty. Students audition to attend and must be a South Carolina resident to apply.

- SAT/ACT scores rank consistently above state and national averages.
- Designated as an "Exemplary School" for 2017-2019 by the Art Schools Network.

SUMMER PROGRAMS

Arts Odyssey • June 14 - 19 or June 21 - 26

A one-week program for rising 8th and 9th grade students. Offers Creative Writing, Drama, Music, and Visual Arts.

- Students apply in 7th and 8th grades
- Program Fee: \$500,* no application fee

Academy Program • July 5 - 18

A two-week program for rising 10th grade students. Offers Creative Writing, Drama, Music, and Visual Arts. Students audition to attend.

- Students apply in 9th grade
- Program Fee: \$950* plus \$25 application fee

Summer Dance Program • June 14 - July 18

A five-week intensive program which offers pre-professional training in ballet and modern dance for rising 7th-12th grade students. Students audition to attend. This program also accepts out-of-state students.

- Students apply in 6th-11th grades and must be 12 years old by June 1, 2019
- Program Fee: \$2,100* plus \$25 application fee

Full and partial scholarships are available for all summer programs based on validated financial need.
