Audition Format

Select applicants will be invited to participate in an in-person audition where they will participate in a drawing workshop and a personal interview. Selection for an audition neither indicates nor implies admission to SCGSAH. *Please note that parents are not permitted to observe the audition.*

DRAWING WORKSHOP

During the 90-minute drawing workshop, applicants will review key drawing terms (<u>watch a short video on drawing terms here</u>), participate in drawing exercises, and do a selection of observational drawings. All drawing materials for the workshop will be provided.

PERSONAL INTERVIEW

During the ~30-minute personal interview, applicants will share more about their art and themselves. Applicants will bring specific pieces from the Portfolio that was submitted to their Application Checklist. Applicants should be prepared to discuss their artistic choices and essay submission.

What to bring from the **Application Portfolio**

- Pencil Self-Portrait
- Three-Dimensional Piece
- Piece of Choice
- Sketchbook with 20+ pages of sketches (more than 20 are encouraged!)
- Do NOT bring additional pieces
