

RESIDENTIAL HIGH SCHOOL PIANO VIRTUAL AUDITION GUIDELINES

Residential High School piano candidates who submit their application materials and audition video may be invited to a fifteen (15) minute virtual audition. Selected students will participate in a sight-reading exercise, demonstrate their musicianship, and participate in an informal interview.

Sight Reading

If selected for a virtual audition, a sight reading example that is well below the level of the solo requirement will be mailed to you in advance of the audition. Do NOT open the sight reading envelope until your virtual audition.

- The day of the virtual audition, only open the sight reading envelope when asked to do so.
- Take a minute to review the selection.
- Then play the sight reading to the best of your ability in one take.

Demonstration of Musicianship

Examples of this may be:

- After hearing a music pattern clapped once, clap the pattern.
- After hearing a pitch played once at the piano, sing that pitch.
- After hearing a chord played once at the piano, sing that chord's highest or lowest pitch.
- After hearing a short melodic pattern played once at the piano, sing the pattern.

Interview

Applicants will participate in a short interview with SCGSAH adjudicators. Be yourself! We want to see your personality and passion.
