

RESIDENTIAL HIGH SCHOOL STRINGS VIRTUAL AUDITION GUIDELINES

Residential High School strings candidates who submit their application materials and audition video may be invited to a ten minute virtual audition. Students will perform scales, demonstrate their musicianship, and participate in an informal interview.

Scales

Perform one major and one minor scale that best demonstrates the student's technical and musical ability.

- Violin, viola, cello – 3 octaves
- Double bass – 2 or 3 octaves as appropriate

Demonstration of Musicianship

Examples of this may be:

- After hearing a music pattern clapped once, clap the pattern.
- After hearing a pitch played once at the piano, sing that pitch.
- After hearing a chord played once at the piano, sing that chord's highest or lowest pitch.
- After hearing a short melodic pattern played once at the piano, sing the pattern.

Interview

Applicants will participate in a short interview with SCGSAH adjudicators. Be yourself! We want to see your personality and passion.
