

RESIDENTIAL HIGH SCHOOL VOICE VIRTUAL AUDITION GUIDELINES

Residential High School voice candidates who submit their application materials and audition video may be invited to a ten (10) minute virtual audition. Students will demonstrate their musicianship, perform their solo, and participate in an informal interview.

Solo

If selected for a virtual audition, you will be asked to sing the solo from your pre-screening video.

- We will begin by helping you vocalize to warm up a bit.
- Be prepared to sing a capella or with a backing track.

Demonstration of Musicianship

Examples of this may be:

- After hearing a music pattern clapped once, clap the pattern.
- After hearing a pitch played once at the piano, sing that pitch.
- After hearing a chord played once at the piano, sing that chord's highest or lowest pitch.
- After hearing a short melodic pattern played once at the piano, sing the pattern.

Interview

Applicants will participate in a short interview with SCGSAH adjudicators. Be yourself! We want to see your personality and passion.
