

## *Food Service Payment Plan*

### *2019-2020 Residential High School*

As a Residential High School, we provide outstanding meals through our food service partner, Aramark. The cost of the annual food service plan is \$3,450.00, payable directly to Aramark. Financial aid is available to qualified families\* to help cover Food Service Fees, and the school allows several interest-free payment options: annual, semi-annual, quarterly, and monthly.

The food service fee is due Friday, July 19, 2019. If you choose any plan other than full payment prior to registration, the financially responsible person will be required to provide some personal information, including social security number.
