

Cost of Attendance

The non-refundable deposit due from all attendees regardless of any financial aid award may be paid online at www.SCGSAH.org or by check or money order on or before Friday, April 17, 2020 (December 18, 2019 for Early Decision). Please write the student's name on the memo line of the check or money order. The balance of the tuition, less any financial aid, must be paid in full prior to the respective date below.

Arts Odyssey Program (2020)

- \$100.00 non-refundable deposit due by Friday, March 13, 2020
- Tuition balance of \$400.00 due by May 15, 2020

Academy Program (2020)

- \$150.00 non-refundable deposit due by Friday, April 17, 2020
- Tuition balance of \$800.00 due by June 5, 2020

Summer Dance Program (2020)

- \$150.00 non-refundable deposit due by Friday, April 17, 2020 (December 18, 2019-Early Decision)
- Tuition balance of \$1,950.00 due by May 15, 2020

Residential High School (2020-2021)

- \$150.00 non-refundable deposit due by Friday, April 17, 2020 (December 18, 2019-Early Decision Dance)
- The Food Service Payment Plan sheet will provide information on cost and payment plans.

The fees above are required for students attending one of the 2020 Summer Programs and/or the 2020-2021 Residential High School. These fees must be paid in accordance with the dates listed above; failure to meet deadlines may result in the loss of a student's space in the program.
